



Out of Eden Learn- Συνοδοιπόροι στο μεγαλύτερο ταξίδι!

Μια καινούρια εμπειρία είχαν οι μαθητές της Δ' τάξης του σχολείου μας. Συμμετείχαν με επιτυχία στο διεθνές εκπαιδευτικό πρόγραμμα "Out of Eden Learn", με υπεύθυνες εκπαιδευτικούς τις Σταυρούλα Κωστάκου και Μαρία Βλάση.

 Το πρόγραμμα "Out of Eden Learn" (OOEL) είναι σχεδιασμένο από την ερευνητική ομάδα Project Zero του Πανεπιστημίου του Harvard, σε συνεργασία με το National Geographic. Τάξεις από όλο τον κόσμο ενώνονται σε "walking parties", ομάδες σχολείων, και ακολουθούν το επικό ταξίδι του δημοσιογράφου Paul Salopek, σε έξι προκαθορισμένα βήματα.

Paul's Walk



In January 2013, Pulitzer Prizewinning journalist Paul Salopek set off from Ethiopia on a seven-year walk

around the world.

His route retraces the migratory pathways of our ancient human ancestors.

As he walks, Paul writes about what he observes and reflects on where we have come in our unfolding human story.

Out of Eden Learn began in 2013 as an experimental collaboration with journalist and National Geographic Fellow Paul Salopek, who is currently engaged in a 21,000-mile 'Out of Eden' walk following the ancient pathways of human migration. It has evolved into a promising model for promoting thoughtful cross-cultural inquiry and exchange, drawing inspiration from the ways in which Salopek and other writers and artists interweave "slow journalism" and local and global storytelling.

Out of Eden Learn is also an active research project that examines such themes as students' conceptions of culture, the character of their online interactions, and what they learn when they slow down to observe the world closely. Read more about our research agenda in our white paper.

Out of Eden Learn is generously funded by the Abundance Foundation, with additional support from Global Cities, Inc., a program of Bloomberg Philanthropies, the National Geographic Society, and Qatar Foundation International. Out of Eden Learn is open to all schools and students, free of charge.


Amidst their hospitality, Salopek said he had to absorb the resentment local people felt about how the outside world judged them, associating Pakistanis with extremist terrorism.

Have you become a weary traveler, or do you still have a lot of gas in the tank?

Paul Salopek:

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How it works

Out of Eden Learn is a free online program for students aged 3-19. The program groups students of similar ages from diverse geographical and socioeconomic settings together for collective learning experiences.

Out of Eden Learn currently offers several 8-12-week long learning experiences, or "learning journeys," designed around three broad learning goals. All of the journeys combine offline activities with online interaction and invite young people to:

- 1. slow down to observe the world carefully and listen attentively to others
- exchange stories and perspectives with one another; and
- make connections between their own lives and bigger human stories.

- Οι τρεις βασικοί μαθησιακοί στόχοι που διέπουν τη φιλοσοφία του Out of Eden Learn: παρατηρώ, αφηγούμαι και αλληλεπιδρώ.
- 1) Οι μαθητές ενθαρρύνονται να σταθούν ,να παρατηρήσουν και να αφουγκραστούν το περιβάλλον τους.
- 2)Ανταλλάσουν ιστορίες και απόψεις μεταξύ τους.
- 3)Κάνουν σύνδεση ανάμεσα στις προσωπικές τους εμπειρίες και οικουμενικά ζητήματα.

 Στα πλαίσια του ΟΟΕL, οι μαθητές μας ήρθαν σε επαφή με μαθητές από τις Ηνωμένες Πολιτείες της Αμερικής, την Ινδία, τον Καναδά, το Βιετνάμ και την Ταϊβάν. Μέσω της ειδικής ψηφιακής πλατφόρμας, τα παιδιά αντάλλαξαν μηνύματα, πληροφορίες και παρουσίασαν τις εργασίες που δημιούργησαν.


Τα παιδιά έφτιαξαν χάρτες της γειτονιάς τους, φωτογράφισαν σημεία που θεωρούν ενδιαφέροντα, πήραν συνέντευξη από ένα μέλος της κοινότητάς τους, εξέφρασαν επιθυμίες για μελλοντικά ταξίδια και όλα αυτά τα μοιράστηκαν με τους διαδικτυακούς τους φίλους.

• Μέσα από τα έξι walking steps του προγράμματος, γίνεται σαφές ότι η διαπολιτισμική επικοινωνία και ο σεβασμός στις απόψεις του άλλου είναι απαραίτητη προϋπόθεση. Ο διάλογος όχι μόνο ενθαρρύνεται αλλά θεωρείται αναγκαίο κομμάτι του προγράμματος και ενισχύεται μέσα από συγκεκριμένα εργαλεία διαλόγου που εύκολα μπορεί να εντοπίσει κανείς στην πλατφόρμα.




Knowing about mountain
